b 65.0 cm: group of 2 pendant cords (1-2), then space of 2.0 cm.

68.0 cm: group of 5 pendant cords (3-7), then space of 3.5 cm.

73.0 cm: group of 3 pendant cords (8-10), then space of 5.5 cm.

79.5 cm: group of 7 pendant cords (11-17), then space of 2.0 cm.

85.0 cm: group of 9 pendant cords (18-26), then space of 22.0 cm.

111.0 cm: 5s, 9.0 cm., 8s, 8.5 cm., 9L, 1.0 cm. ç (589)

#### Observations

1. This is one of several quipus acquired by the Museum in 1899 with provenance Marquez. This group includes AS106, AS107, AS124, AS132, and AS133. For a comparison of them, see AS106.
2. By spacing, the quipu is separated into groups that contain different numbers of pendants.
3. Assuming that P20 has value 108, the knots on the main cord represent a value that is the sum of the values on the 9 pendants in the last group.
