The pendants are finished c but those in the first 9 groups (211-273) have no knots. The last group has knots and so the lengths and values are recorded.

Observations

- 1. This is one of several quipus acquired by the Museum in 1907 with provenance Pachacamac. For a list of them, see AS97.
- 2. By spacing, the quipu is separated into 2 parts. Part 1 consists of 10 subparts, each of which is 7 groups of 3 pendants. Each of the 70 groups has the same color pattern: W, B, W. Part 2 consists of 10 groups of 7 pendants each. The pendants in groups 1 and 10 are B, and those in groups 2-9 are BB.
- 3. In part 1, all the pendants in the first 9 subparts are zero-valued (or blank). Similarly, in part 2, all the pendants in the first 9 groups are zero-valued (or blank).

4. This quipu is probably incomplete. The values on the 70 pendants in part 2 perhaps were to be related to the 70 groups of part 1.
