Observations

- *1. Construction note: 4*1 is a pendant 21 cm. long attached to the bottom of pendant 4. It appears to be a recent attachment.
- **2. Construction note: The color designation W/RM refers to a white cord with thin thread wrapped around it. The thread wrapping forms a .5 cm. wide band from 2.5 cm.-3.0 cm.
