

## Observations

- 1. AS182-AS186 are associated in that they are tied together.
  - a) Tied with the group of quipus is a cord with 22 single knots.



- b) Eleven different basic colors are used in this group of quipus. None uses all of them but each shares at least one color with the others.
- c) With the exception of AS185, the only values on the quipus are 0-11 and multiples of 5 from 15 to 90.
