

Observations

- 1. Construction note: In group 2, the first and second pendant are paired and the third and fourth pendant are paired by special construction.
 - (a) A double length cord was bent in half,
 - (b) and then slipped through itself around main cord forming 2 adjacent pendants.



- 2. By spacing, these are two groups of pendants. All cords are the same color.
- 3. Long knots occur consistantly in hundreds, tens, and units positions. No single knots occur.
- 4. The value of pendant 9 is the sum of the values of pendants 6 and 7.
